MY STUDENT TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

- STAY HOME AND ISOLATE FROM SCHOOL & OTHER ACTIVITIES FOR AT LEAST **FIVE DAYS** (DAY SYMPTOMS BEGAN IS "DAY ZERO")
- ASSUMING SYMPTOMS IMPROVE (OR STUDENT REMAINS ASYMPTOMATIC) STUDENT MAY RETURN TO CAMPUS ON DAY SIX.
- DURING DAYS 6-10 AFTER DIAGNOSIS, STUDENT SHOULD WEAR N95/KN95 OR "DOUBLE MASK" WHEN ON CAMPUS AND WILL BE ASKED TO EAT LUNCH/SNACK IN A DESIGNATED SPACE AWAY FROM OTHERS. STUDENT SHOULD ALSO REFRAIN FROM BAND & CHOIR.
- ON DAY 11, STUDENT MAY RETURN TO NORMAL CAMPUS ACTIVITY.

MY STUDENT IS A "HOUSEHOLD CLOSE CONTACT" TO AN ACTIVE CASE OF COVID-19

For example: a member of student's immediate household family such as a parent or sibling who live under the same roof tests positive.

- NO QUARANTINE REQUIRED.
- YOUR STUDENT SHOULD WEAR A MASK WHENEVER ON CAMPUS FOR THE 10-DAY PERIOD FOLLOWING THE POSITIVE TEST RESULT RETURNED BY THE HOUSEHOLD MEMBER.
- YOUR STUDENT SHOULD UTILIZE THE FREE RAPID COVID-19 TESTS AVAILABLE FROM THE SCHOOL OFFICE, AND FOLLOW THE "TEST-TO-STAY" METHOD, TESTING IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE CONFIRMED HOUSEHOLD CASE, AND THEN EVERY 2-3 DAYS FOR THE 10-DAY PERIOD FOLLOWING.
- ON DAY 11, STUDENT MAY RETURN TO NORMAL CAMPUS ACTIVITY.

MY STUDENT WAS A "SOCIAL CLOSE CONTACT" TO AN ACTIVE CASE OF COVID-19

For example: shared a classroom, participated in sports/activities with, or attended other social gathering lasting more than a combined 15 minutes over a 24-hour period.

- NO QUARANTINE REQUIRED.
- YOUR STUDENT IS HIGHLY ENCOURAGED TO WEAR A MASK WHENEVER ON CAMPUS FOR THE 10-DAY PERIOD FOLLOWING THE DATE OF EXPOSURE.
- YOUR STUDENT IS HIGHLY ENCOURAGED TO UTILIZE THE FREE RAPID COVID-19 TESTS AVAILABLE FROM THE SCHOOL OFFICE, AND TEST 3-5 DAYS AFTER DATE OF EXPOSURE.
- CLOSELY MONITOR YOUR STUDENT'S HEALTH OVER THE 10 DAYS FOLLOWING EXPOSURE AND TEST IMMEDIATELY SHOULD SYMPTOMS ARISE.

MY STUDENT IS EXHIBITING SYMPTOMS COMMON WITH COVID-19

If student is experiencing: cough, difficulty breathing, fever, loss of taste or smell, chills, fatigue, muscle/body aches, headache, sore throat, congestion, nausea/vomiting/diarrhea (at discretion of staff)

- REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS OR COVID-19 HISTORY, PLEASE REMAIN OFF CAMPUS FOR AT LEAST 24 HRS.
- STUDENT MAY RETURN TO CAMPUS ONCE THEY HAVE PRODUCED A NEGATIVE TEST RESULT AND SYMPTOMS HAVE IMPROVED. STUDENT SHOULD WEAR A MASK ON CAMPUS UNTIL SYMPTOMS HAVE RESOLVED.
- PLEASE NOTE, A TEACHER MAY ASK TO SEND A STUDENT HOME IF SYMPTOMS BECOME A DISTRACTION IN CLASS
